Match Schedule

Format:

- White Ball, 35 over cricket.
- League format – All teams will play single round robin matches in the league stage.
- Top 2 teams will go directly to the final after league stage.
- All matches will be played at Ultimate Sports Academy Ground (Subject to Change based on International or Other Events)
- 2 pts for a win, 1 pt for a no result. A tied match during group stages is 1 pteach.
- The fixtures shared by the USA need to be followed by all teams. USA has the right to reschedule any matches based on Ground Maintenance/International Events.

COVID 19:

- In these unprecedented times of COVID 19, personal responsibility is placed on each team and facility to fulfill all the safety and precautionary guidelines of each relevant Sports Council. Maintenance of social distancing and wearing of masks whilst not on the field of play is essential in compliance with the regulations.

**ALL MATCHES WILL BE PLAYED UNDER THE STANDARD MCC LAWS OF CRICKET (5TH EDITION)
EXCEPT AS VARIED HERE UNDER OR AS DECIDED BY USA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

Summarized important notes:

- Wides will not be rebowled, except in the last over. 2 runs will be awarded for every wide ball.
- One white ball will be used per innings.

Tied Match:

- If the game ends in a tie, then both teams shall share 1 point each during the league stages. During the semi-final & final, the teams shall complete in a One over Per Side Eliminator to determine the winner. Follow ICC regulations on Super Over.

Interrupted or Prematurely Terminated Matches

- If the innings of the side batting second is suspended (with at least 13 overs bowled) and it is not possible for the match to be resumed, the match will be decided by comparison with the DLS 'Par Score' determined at the instant of the suspension by the latest update of the Duckworth/Lewis/Stern method (Refer Duck-worth/Lewis/Stern Regulations).
- If the score is equal to the par score, the match is a Tie. Otherwise the result is a victory, or defeat, by the margin of runs by which the score exceeds, or falls short of, the Par Score.

Timing of Play: Covered in detail below

- The match will start at 30 Mins from the reporting time & with the toss to be done **15**

- **mins from the reporting time.**
- Teams not able to toss **15 minutes before the start time will automatically lose the toss.**
- Team reporting **after 30 minutes from the 'Match Start Time'** or not present at that time will deem to have conceded a walkover. The umpire (s) present will award a walkover to other team provided they are present at the stipulated time with minimum seven (7) players. Teams can request to continue the match if there is a legitimate reason or have been informed prior of the situation by the team arriving late. Common sense to be applied with a focus on players having a chance to play.
- If both the teams arrive after the match start time, but before the walk over time, both will be penalized by deduction of overs from their allotted quota and the play time will be reduced / adjusted accordingly.
- **Minimum of seven (7) players** shall take the field for the commencement of the match.
- Each innings will be of **2 hours duration with 1 drinks break (after the 15th over of the innings) followed by a 10 minute change over between the innings.**
- All fielding sides are required to complete their 30 overs in the allotted time of **2 hours.** Deliberate slow play can be actioned by the umpire for a further disciplinary committee hearing.

BOWLERS QUOTA:

- Each bowler have to bowl minimum of 3 overs in an innings maximum of 5.

NO BALLS / SHORT PITCH DELIVERIES / WIDE BALLS

- A bowler shall be limited to one fast short pitched delivery per over.
- A fast short pitched delivery is defined as a ball which passes or would have passed above the shoulder height of the striker standing upright at the crease.
- In the event of more than one a fast short pitched delivery per over being bowled shall call and signal NO BALL on each occasion. To call a "NO Ball" for fast short pitched delivery will be the responsibility of the main umpire.
- If there is a second instance of the bowler being no balled in the innings for bowling more than one fast short pitched delivery in an over, the umpire shall advise the bowler that this is his final warning for the innings.
- Should there be any further instance by the same bowler in that innings, the umpire shall call and signal no ball and when the ball is dead direct the captain to take the bowler off forthwith.
- A ball that passes above head height of the batsman , that prevents him from being able to hit it with his bat by means of a normal cricket stroke shall be called a wide.
- Two runs will be awarded to batting team for every WIDE BALL and the ball will not be rebowled except in the last over of each innings.
- In addition to the above delivery following a no ball called for a foot fault (Law 24.5) shall be a free hit for whichever batsman is facing it. If the delivery for the free hit is not legitimate delivery (any kind of no ball or wide ball) then the next delivery will be become free hit for whichever batsman is facing .
- No Balls will be awarded 1 run as well as a free hit for the next ball (extraball).
- Free Hit will be awarded for each No Ball.

FIELDING RESTRICTIONS

- A fielding restrictions shall apply to the first 8 overs of each innings. During the Fielding Restrictions over's only two fieldsmen shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area at the instant of delivery.
- During the Non Fielding Restrictions over's, no more than 5 fieldsmen shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area at the instant of delivery.

Disciplinary Actions

- Any violation on field of rules or disciplinary actions will be decided by the on field umpires and their decision will be final. Only captains are allowed to approach and discuss matters with on field umpires.
- If teams are unable to fulfill a fixture, a forfeit will be given to the opposing team (Final decision will be upto USA management).
- USA has the right to disqualify any team/Player, if any Player/team violates the rules of the tournament in any form.

All rules are subject to change and or sudden upgrade by the committee as per situation occurs. In the event when disputes over the rules arise, the decision of the Ultimate Sports Academy Official Tournament Committee will be considered as final.
